Evangelical Radio Ministry

MODENA -- A simple but touching ground-breaking ceremony for the new site of Voce della Bibbia (Voice of the Bible) was held Sunday May 11th in Formigine (Modena.)

Voce della Bibbia is the Italian branch of the well-known Back to the Bible Broadcast of Lincoln, Nebraska. This evangelical radio ministry had its humble beginning some 20 years ago in Modena, initiated by Arthur and Erma Wiens.

At that time, a few 15 minute programs were heard by short wave. Now daily programs of interest to all ages can be heard on FM over 22 Evangelical stations throughout the country. Some 40 commercial stations also air the recorded programs on cassettes and reels which reach their various destination through the Italian mail.

Just as all the ministries of Voce della Bibbia have been supported by the free-will gifts and offerings of God's people throughout the world, so the costs of construction will be met in the same way.

The new construction is also to house the Italian branch of Radio station HCJB of Quito, Equador. Mr. and Mrs. Harry Yeomen, originally from New Zealand, now living in Formigine have come to represent this work. Following the Sunday ceremony, the Yeomens invited all the participants to their apartment for an abundant and beautiful display of delightful refreshments.
